## Discussion with Timothy Taylor about *Story House*

Timothy Taylor is the recipient of the National Magazine Award, and winner of the Journey Prize. His debut novel, *Stanley Park*, was nominated for the Giller Prize and chosen for the 2004 One Book, One Vancouver book club. His short fiction has appeared in many of Canada's leading literary magazines. He was born in Venezuela and now lives in Vancouver.

*In Story House, Taylor takes on the eccentric world of architectural design – with boxing, fishing and reality TV thrown in. Half-brothers Graham and Elliot Gordon are the only sons of a famous architect. The boys are openly hostile towards each other, until their father decides they will settle their differences in the boxing ring. Three rounds and twenty years later, the story reconvenes as the brothers come together to reconstruct a nostalgic piece of architecture, with the help of a popular reality TV show.*
