While your child is listening to stories, you can sit at the tables and cut out the foam pieces for the craft and help prepare snack. The little craft can be affixed to your child's book bag using a pin and hot glue, set up by the stage.

Please work quietly as your young ones may have difficulty listening for the first few sessions and need no extra distractions. If your child is anxious about you sitting at the table while they are on the carpet, you may join them on the carpet and ask the volunteer to help prepare your child's craft. Please sit behind your child, so that others will be able to see clearly.

After I have finished reading the stories, the children will move to chairs at the tables and you will guide them from behind their seats. We will have a special Knuffle Bunny

snack, which they will help make. They will then make a foam craft from pieces you have cut out and then later make a friendship bracelet with you.
