Drawing and Writing with the Birds

Tuesday March 9 to Thursday March 11 (3 Classes)

Fee: \$140 *(Includes cost of a shadow box)*

We'll begin the workshop by walking to Jericho beach, identifying birds as we go. Once there, we'll sketch birds in words and images. Each child will use these initial sketches and notes to create further art studies and creative writing pieces the following day. Finally, the children will integrate their learning by making an intricate and beautiful shadow box on Thursday.



Flight of the Hummingbird

We'll begin by talking about the role birds play in West Coast storytelling. After exploring some beautiful First Nation picture books, each child will make a visual representation of a bird using pearl buttons on a felted placemat.
